Special Meeting September 27, 2024

Called for 4:30 p.m. and broadcast from the Media Arts Studio, 454 Broadway, to entertain a motion to convene in Executive Session for the purpose of discussing strategy for contract negotiations with nonunion personnel (Interim Superintendent) as an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating positions of the School Committee.
