That Superintendent's Recommendation #24-128 Grant Award, be adopted as follows: that the School Committee accept and approve the grant award below in the amount and for the period indicated:

FY25 Civics Teaching and Learning (SC25207) Trust in the amount of \$52,516.00 for the period of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025.

Description: The purpose of this competitive grant program is to support civics teaching and learning, including implementation of grade 8 and high school civics projects, the hosting of local civics project showcases, participation in Massachusetts Regional Civics Project Showcases, and instruction and activities associated with the 2024 elections, including voter registration activities. The grant will be used to:

- Support stipends and SOA days and educator texts to facilitate civics educator professional development, collaboration around the new 8th grade civics MCAS requirement, and coordination of an expanded 8th grade civics showcase;
- Venue, transportation, and materials for a civics project showcase which includes all 8th graders;
- Supplies and materials related to 2024 election across the district, including electoral maps, "I Voted" stickers, and a civics-focused family engagement event.
