SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: CCS Presentation Systems

Purpose: To update the aging projectors at CRLS with current display technology that will enhance teaching and learning. In order to ensure timely processing and delivery, it is beneficial to have an open contract in place.

Amount of Contract: \$500,000.00

Description/Scope of Services:

The projectors at CRLS were installed during the building renovation project over twelve years ago, and thus are in need of updating with current technology that meets the needs of students and teachers. The goal of this project is to provide display technology that allows for seamless access to digital content, capacity for user interaction to demonstrate learning, and wireless projection from teacher and student devices to enhance collaboration. The project will also update the building network infrastructure to include additional network drops in each classroom allowing enhanced management and use of the technology.
