SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Amplify

Purpose: To implement a research-based, DESE-approved early literacy screener and diagnostic tool, with embedded tools for dual-language assessment, multi-tiered intervention, K-2 adaptive learning software and caregiver engagement.

Amount of Contract: \$131,377.90

Summary Description / Scope of Services:

The MA State Legislature enacted legislation (Regulation 603 CMR 28.03(1)(f)) that goes into effect on July 1, 2023 requiring all districts to screen students in K-3 on early literacy measures that are predictive of reading difficulties, particularly dyslexia. DESE provided districts with guidance on how to implement these regulations, and put forth a set of fully approved early literacy screeners. The only fully DESE approved early literacy screener that is digitally available to students across grades K-3 is Amplify's mCLASS® (DIBELS-8).

The Amplify Suite includes the mCLASS® screener / diagnostic tool; mCLASS® Lectura (providing dual-language screening / reporting); mCLASS® Intervention (research-proven, teacher-directed, intensive intervention lessons); and Boost Reading (K-2 supplemental adaptive learning in phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension).

The Amplify suite will replace the existing CPS K-2 screener, additional analysis software, and various, inconsistent diagnostic and intervention tools. This program aligns to our department's goal of systematically reviewing and aligning teaching and learning resources to a few high-quality, research-proven tools that ensure increased consistency, educator support and student impact across the district. Ongoing professional learning is included in the cost and implementation plan.
