Purpose: Social Emotional Learning Screener

Amount of Contract: \$30,635

Description/Scope of Services:

This is for the renewal of Aperture Education's DESSA, a universal Social Emotional Learning (SEL) screener, to allow for continued usage in our CPS grades K-10. This data has been critical to CPS SEL work. Having an SEL screener in place allows CPS to proactively identify students who need additional SEL supports and track the impact of these interventions. The data also informs class-wide and school-wide SEL Tier 1 curriculum and expectations. Having this tool in place, alongside professional learning about SEL and the data, will ensure more students are supported in these critical areas.

This tool meets the CPS established criteria of being: asset-based, culturally responsive, validated, and action-oriented with built-in SEL professional learning.
