SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Lexia Learning Systems

<u>Purpose:</u> To provide the initial (Unit 1) LETRS training to an additional two cohorts of educators (Cohorts E and F-80 participants) and Unit 2 LETRS training to 40 individuals who completed Unit 1 from cohorts A-D, with a priority placed on coaches and interventionists serving early childhood grades.

Summary Description / Scope of Services:

LETRS® (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) is designed to, "Provide educators with deep knowledge to be literacy and language experts in the science of reading and reading instruction— phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, writing, and language." This professional learning will allow CPS educators to develop shared knowledge of evidence-based reading practices, and empower them to prevent and address reading difficulties early on.

LETRS provides a comprehensive professional learning opportunity that meets the needs of educators through a combination of synchronous and asynchronous learning. Engaging, interactive online modules reinforce concepts, show videos of expert teaching, and provide practical ways to apply learning in the classroom. This is complemented by reading and reflection in the LETRS workbook. Asynchronous work can be completed at times that are convenient for educators between synchronous sessions. The full-days of synchronous professional development include opportunities to address and discuss authentic classroom scenarios with small groups of educators and the support of an expert facilitator. Different from other science of reading PD programs, LETRS includes *Bridge to Practice* activities that provide educators with ongoing practice of learned strategies
