**DESCRIPTION:** The purpose of this grant is to provide resources to host after school coding clubs at schools. The Broad Institute provides all of the materials and staff to implement the program. This grant has been increased from \$2,250 to \$3,000 to add an after school coding club at Vassal Lane Upper School in the spring of 2024. FY24 grant funds will support:

- After school coding clubs at Amigos School, Cambridge Street Upper School, Putnam Avenue Upper School, and Vassal Lane Upper School;
- Stipends for a teacher at each school to serve as club advisor (\$750 per teacher, per semesterlong club).
