DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this reimbursement grant program is to support students enrolled in the district who were housed in a state-identified expanded homeless shelter in Cambridge between December 15, 2023 and June 25, 2024. This represents an increase of \$203,381.71 for a new total award of \$277,958.50.

- This payment is based on the number of days each eligible student was enrolled at CPS during the eligible period and is funded at a level of \$104.89 per student, per day.
- The funds can be used in FY24 or FY25 to support instructional services and any other services that the district is providing to eligible students and their families.
