Purpose: This contract is for professional development services for the Haggerty School's Cycles of Improvement and Resources

Amount of Contract: \$26,773.00

Description/Scope of Services:

CLEE provides yearlong school based Cycles of Improvement and resources needed to administer the Learning Community Survey to all educators in the school and provides a digital dashboard. This allows CPS staff to analyze and develop steps to increase educational equity. CLEE will lead a professional learning designed training to support CPS efforts to learn more about student behavior and the intersection of academic learning & student behavior through equity based cycles of improvement.
