SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: PJ Systems dba HiQ Computers

Purpose: This contract with HiQ provides essential annual maintenance and support for the district's core technology infrastructure, including networking, cybersecurity, and the Classlink single sign-on solution.

Amount of Contract: \$700,000.00

Description/Scope of Services:

- **Network/Professional Services :** Ongoing high-level engineering support for virtual server environment monitoring, configuration, and enterprise backup/disaster recovery.
- SonicWall: Annual licensing and maintenance for the district's firewall and web filter.
- Backupify: Annual licensing for G-Suite user data backup.
- **CrowdStrike:** Annual subscription for antivirus endpoint protection on all district-owned devices.
- FileWave: Annual licensing for remote device management software.
- Managed Methods): Annual licensing for G-Suite security software, enabling data security monitoring and management.
- Virtual Environment/Disaster Recovery Upgrade: Purchase of storage devices critical for the virtual environment and disaster recovery.
- Aerohive Licensing and Support: Support and licensing for the wireless infrastructure, enabling firmware updates.
- VMWare Support and Maintenance: Support and software updates for the VMWare environment.
- VML Warranty Extension : Annual warranty extension for the Tier 2 Disk Array.
- Air Gap Annual Maintenance: Ongoing support for the disaster recovery system.
- Classlink: Annual licensing for the district's single sign-on solution.
- Staff Devices: Annual replacement of administrative staff devices.

E-rate Program Summary:

The federal E-rate program, administered by the FCC, assists schools in building technology capacity by providing discounts on eligible services. Currently, eligible services include internet connectivity and certain network-related costs. CPS receives E-rate discounts on internet costs and select network hardware, including this year's WiFi licensing and a portion of the firewall purchase. Reimbursement rates, ranging from 20% to 90%, are determined by factors such as urban/rural status and poverty levels. CPS' current reimbursement rate is 60% for eligible services.
