DESCRIPTION: Title I provides financial assistance to districts and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards. FY26 Title I grant will:

- Fund ELA and Math teaching staff and/or other targeted academic interventions at two elementary schools – Fletcher Maynard Academy and King Open; three upper schools – Cambridge Street Upper School, Darby Vassall Upper School, and Putnam Avenue Upper School; and, the High School Extension Program;
- Fund a Title I Coordinator and Title I MTSS Coordinator;
- Provide for extensive caregiver, family and community engagement activities throughout the year; partially fund the CPS summer program; and, provide services to eligible students in private schools.

DISTRICT PLAN ALIGNMENT: Title I will support the following Strategic Initiatives: 1.3 - Establish robust multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS) to support students' academic, social, emotional, and behavioral needs. 4.10 - Improve families' access to resources within and beyond CPS.
