**DESCRIPTION:** The purpose of this grant is to provide resources to host after school coding clubs at CPS schools. The Broad Institute provides all of the materials and staff to implement the program. Grant funds will support:

- After school coding clubs at Amigos, Putnam Avenue Upper School, and Rindge Avenue Upper School during the 2025-26 school year;
- Stipends for a teacher at each school to serve as club advisor (\$500 per teacher, per semester-long club).
