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SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Public Consulting Group Contract

Purpose: Medicaid Reimbursement Claiming Services

Contract Amount: \$97,750

Description/Scope of Services:

The Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) includes provisions which allow school districts to seek Medicaid reimbursement for health care related services when provided to an eligible student in accordance with the student's individual education plan (IEP). Examples of services eligible for reimbursement include behavioral health services, and physical, occupational and speech/language therapy.

The regulations pertaining to the federal cost reporting and claiming system are complex, as is the process for documenting and completing the quarterly claim filings. In order to ensure that we comply with regulations and maximize our revenue recovery, the district contracts with the Public Consulting Group (PCG) to assist with the claim process. The district's annual revenue from the Federal Medicaid Reimbursement program ranges from \$1.0 to \$1.6 million. The fee for these services 6% of revenue received in a fiscal year. In FY 2018, the district received approximately \$1.4 million.
