## SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: CCS Presentation Systems

**Purpose:** To provide interactive display hardware to schools and departments. In order to ensure timely processing and delivery, it is beneficial to have an open contract in place.

Amount of Contract: \$50,000.00

## **Description/Scope of Services:**

Aging Hardware – Replacement of aging/broken interactive display hardware across the district in instructional spaces. Approximately 60% of the interactive display technology in K-5 classrooms is over 5 years old (with some closer to 12 years old) and each year several of those classrooms need to be replaced. The interactive display technology in the Upper Schools was installed in 2012 with the Innovation Agenda, and again a couple classrooms each year need to be replaced. At CRLS, the interactive display technology was installed in 2010 and many of the projectors are nearing end of life from the renovation.

New Instructional Spaces – As classrooms and instructional spaces are added to schools, interactive technology is sometimes necessary to complete the classroom technology package.
