
That Superintendent's Recommendation #20-138, Grant Award, be adopted as follows: That the School Committee accept and approve the grant award in the amount and for the period indicated:

Food & Nutrition Services Appropriation, for the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021, in the amount of \$1,200,000.00. Project/Grant SC00402.

Description: The FY 2021 projected budget for the Food and Nutrition FY21 is \$3,952,993. The budget is supported through revenue is generated throughout the year from school breakfast and lunch programs, including Federal and State reimbursements and receipts from paid meals, and through a reimbursement from the City and a CPS general Fund subsidy. To support improved engagement with Cambridge families, management of department promotions, and monitoring and evaluation of department communications, the FY21 Budget added a 1.0 FTE nutrition communications and engagement specialist to be paid from the Food Services Revolving Fund.

This Recommendation: At the beginning of each year, to enable the department to conduct business seamlessly from the start of the year, a recommendation is put forth to the School Committee to initially appropriate the anticipated Federal and State revenues. The initial recommended appropriation is based on 80% of the Federal and State revenues received in FY20.
