Special Meeting January 8, 2025

Called for Wednesday, January 8, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. and broadcast from the Media Arts Studio, 454 Broadway, Cambridge for the purpose of entertaining a motion to convene in an Executive Session to hear two Level III grievances (CEA Units A&B) as part of collective bargaining as an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining and litigation positions of the School Committee.
