Broad Institute Codings Clubs (SC24153) from Private, Allocation in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the period of September 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024.

<u>Description</u>: The purpose of this grant is to provide resources to host after-school coding clubs at schools. The Broad Institute provides all of the materials and staff to implement the program. This grant has been increased from \$2,250 to \$3,000 to add an after-school coding club at Vassal Lane Upper School in the spring of 2024. FY24 grant funds will support:
