That the Superintendent's Recommendation #24-041 (Second Reading) be adopted as follows: That the School Committee approve the Policy and Procedures for the Administration of Prescription Medication and for the Management of Life-Threatening Food Allergies in the School Setting as detailed in the attached document. This is the same Policy and Procedures for the Administration of Prescription Medication and for the Management of Life-Threatening Food Allergies in School Settings that is currently in place but in accordance with state regulations the Policy and Procedures need to be periodically reviewed in conjunction with the Public Health Department.
