## Description:

2. <u>Equipment Costs</u>: To fund the purchase of four aerial lifts by the School Department's Facilities Division. The transfers requested to fund this expense are a reduction to Salaries, Wages & Benefits of (\$50,000) and an increase to Extraordinary Expenditures of \$50,000.
