Cambridge Hospital Legacy Project (SC23177) Private, allocation in the amount of \$23,000.00 for the period of March 23, 2023 to August 31, 2024.

<u>Description:</u> This grant increase from Cambridge Hospital will support a field trip for 8 students and 2 staff chaperones from the High School Extension Program (HSEP) traveling to the Legacy Museum and related sites in Montgomery, Alabama in June 2024. A grant of \$10,000 was received and accepted in FY23. This increase of \$13,000 brings the total grant award to \$23,000. Grant funds will be used for:
