SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: The New England Center for Children

Purpose: To provide comprehensive services for children with autism: through day and residential programs, partner classrooms in public school systems, consulting services and autism curriculum software for teachers.

Amount of Contract: Not to exceed \$30,000.00

Description/Scope of Services:

New England Center for Children (NECC) will provide access to the Autism Curriculum Encyclopedia (ACE) program. Educators will use the ACE application to help structure individualized lesson plans for students with Autism based on each student's needs and abilities. ACE will allow educators to oversee student programming. Educators with be able to generate reports in order to provide data which will be used in constructing IEP's and student goals.
