Description:

The FY 2023 projected budget for the Food and Nutrition Services Department is \$3,855,860. The budget is supported through revenue generated throughout the year from school breakfast and lunch programs, including Federal and State reimbursements and receipts from paid meals, and through a reimbursement from the City and a CPS general fund subsidy.

This recommendation: At the beginning of each year, to enable the department to conduct business seamlessly from the start of the year, a recommendation is put forth to the School Committee to initially appropriate the anticipated Federal and State revenues. This initial recommended appropriation is based on an estimate of the Federal and State revenues CPS will receive in FY 2023.
