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SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Benjamin Franklin Cummings Institute of Technology

Purpose: For the 2022-2023 school year, the Cambridge Public Schools and Benjamin Franklin Cummings Institute of Technology will establish a partnership that provides up to one year of course credits, educational support, and full access the college's services to qualified students at no cost to them. Three – five students will be enrolled through the Advance Standing Associates Program (ASAP) for summer through spring semesters. The goal is to have 3 fully released seniors in the fall and 2 partially released juniors.

Amount of Contract: \$65,000
(\$13,000 per student)

Description/Scope of Services:

Advanced Standing Associates Program (ASAP)

- ASAP will provide information sessions about degree awarding programs onsite at CPS and virtually, along with promotional materials
- Students will receive campus tours and allow them to connect with Program Chairs and other staff or faculty, as needed and appropriate.
- ASAP will provide one year of course credits and educational support.
- ASAP will provide students with free textbooks and access to tools a personalized ASAP pathway, which outlines each class they are required to complete each semester to achieve one year of college education through the program.
- ASAP will Support students' transition to college through high touch advising. Provide students access to all resources available on campus such as: The Academic Success Center and online tutoring, Online Library, online resources, such as Canvas and Institution student email address.
