Description:

The FY 2023 Perkins grant will fund the purchase of advanced electronic equipment for the Automotive Program and a convection oven for the Culinary Arts Program. It will also support the services of veterinary and animal research consultants to assist with the design of a new course and laboratory space for an animal research component in the Biotech program. Funds will also support the creation of public information materials for all RSTA programs, and the cost of attendance for the Director and 3 RSTA staff members at the national conference of the Association of Career and Technical Education (ACTE), an event that provides valuable professional development opportunities in current ACTE practices.
