All children of school age who meet the school entrance age criteria and of school age who actually reside in the City of Cambridge shall be entitled to attend the public schools, as well as certain children who do not reside in the City but who are considered homeless under the McKinney Vento Act and/or are admitted under School Committee policies relating to nonresident students or by specific action of the School Committee.

Advance registration for prospective kindergarten students will take place on a rolling basis starting in January for the following school year and is considered the "First Cycle" under the Cambridge Public Schools Controlled Choice Policy and each month thereafter is considered a cycle. Every student seeking admission to school for the first time must present a birth certificate or equivalent proof of age acceptable to the Family Resource Student Registration Center and proof of vaccination and immunizations as required by the state and the School Committee. Proof of residency of legal guardianship is also required.
