GIFTS / MISCELLANEOUS RECEIPTS:

1. \$10,000 from Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study at Harvard University to support the Emerging Leaders Program (ELP). ELP is a youth leadership development program that brings together local high school students and Harvard undergraduates to engage in discussions and action on themes related to gender and leadership, social movements, and civic engagement. Funds will be used for stipends for two CRLS teachers to help lead the program.
2. \$997.43 from HELPSY to the Kennedy Longfellow School in return for items collected in the school's clothing/book donation collection box. Funds will be used for the general support of the school.
