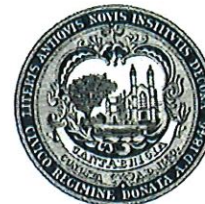

DESCRIPTION: This grant increase from Cambridge Hospital will support a field trip for 8 students and 2 staff chaperones from the High School Extension Program (HSEP) traveling to the Legacy Museum and related sites in Montgomery, Alabama in June 2024. A grant of \$10,000 was received and accepted in FY23. This increase of \$13,000 brings the total grant award to \$23,000. Grant funds will be used for:


- Airfare, lodging, ground transportation, and meals for visits to the Legacy Museum, The National Memorial for Peace and Justice, and the Freedom Monument Sculpture Park in Alabama;
- Museum admissions, tour costs, and a gift shop allowance for each student per the funder.
