ACA - NON-DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF SEX

The Cambridge School Committee, in accordance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, declares that the school district does not and will not discriminate on the basis of sex, sex stereotypes, sex characteristics, marital status, familial status, pregnancy or pregnancy-related conditions and prohibits sex discrimination in any education program or activity that it operates, as required by Title IX, including in admission and employment, in the educational programs and activities of the public schools. This policy will extend not only to students with regard to educational opportunities, but also to employees with regard to employment opportunities. The School Committee further incorporates as if fully set forth herein its policy entitled Cambridge Public Schools Non-Discrimination Policy and Prohibition Against Sexual Harassment.

The School Committee will continue to ensure fair and equitable educational and employment opportunities, without regard to sex, to all of its students and employees.

The School Committee directs the Superintendent to designate an individual to act as the school district's Title IX compliance officer. All students and employees will be notified of the name and office address and telephone number of the compliance officer.

The Cambridge Public Schools shall provide a notice of non-discrimination along with the contact information for its Title IX Coordinator in accordance with guidance issued by the United States Department of Education. The notice shall be given to students, parents/guardians/caregivers, or other authorized legal representatives of elementary school and secondary school students; employees; applicants for admission and employment; and all unions and professional organizations holding collective bargaining or professional agreements with the Cambridge Public Schools.

The District shall prominently include all elements of its notice of nondiscrimination set out above on its website and in each handbook, catalog, announcement, bulletin, and application form that it makes available to persons entitled to notice under this section, or which are otherwise used in connection with the recruitment of students or employees.
