That the following was adopted as amended:

That Whereas Cambridge Public Schools (CPS) strives to provide equitable learning environments across the district; and

Whereas the twelve Cambridge Public Schools elementary school buildings differ in age, quality, and condition of maintenance; and

Whereas the City of Cambridge shares responsibility with CPS for school buildings; and

Whereas the Cambridge Public Schools administration has estimated that CPS buildings will require \$132 million in maintenance upgrades over the next five years, which is an average of \$26 million per year; Therefore, the School Committee requests that the CPS Administration invite members of the Cambridge City Council to tour CPS buildings that are in the greatest need of maintenance.
