Equity in test scores - low income and Black students have much lower proficiency rates This is not just relative to white and non low income students in the school but also relative to other low income and Black students across the state and within Cambridge

Area identified for improvement is multi tiered student support

- all students are in Tier 1- high quality instruction in the classroom
- there are other tiers for varying levels of support
- the multi-tiered support systems are not well coordinated and staff have reported negative consequences and requested help
- this were issues before pandemic and pandemic exacerbated these issues
