- What is working well for families as our feedback from the last survey was excellent (highest in the district)?
- Are there families who need better access?
- What is the goal? Should we have focus groups to find out what is most helpful for families?
- Should there be a What's App for the classroom? How to connect those families? How do we know who is on What's App? Is this the best tool?
- Ideas about how to make family connections on non-school days (staff PD days and holidays)
- Should we have peer pals mentor families connecting existing families with a new family? How can we provide that connection?
- How do parents support each other starting in preschool?
- Can we have something like Village Leaders for each grade level?
- What are the best practices for Room Parents? Could we spend a meeting talking/formalizing the role of room parents?
- Paper must be included in communication. (More use of flyers.)
