#### **MEETING NOTES:**

- SC Presentation: <u>APRIL 30 SLIDESHOW</u>
- Dr. Babio-James welcomed all attendees to the School Council meeting and launched introductions.
- A brainstorming session kicked off focused on the topic: How do we get more parents to step up and serve on the School Council and PAFA? Discussions continued and ideas were shared, including around partnership, family engagement, offering more invitations to join PAFA and the School Council, timing (e.g., having multiple types of engagement opportunities based on shift work), and offering a framework to make parents, caregivers and educators successful. In addition, make a greater effort to build trusted relationships with parents and caregivers, and an area of improvement for next year.
- The Minutes from the School Council meetings for Jan and Mar were approved.
- **Budget Update:** as of today, the budget has not been returned from the City solicitor, and we are not clear if any impact on the SIP budget. Reference the slidedeck on the Budget (General + SIP).
- **PAUS and Community Updates** reference the slidedeck. Updates included an invitation to join the committees to take part in an interview panel for open positions (i.e., in person interviews).
- School Council and PAFA Election Plans: the slide deck includes information about the upcoming elections for both Student Council (3 positions) and PAFA. The election process will be shared by email to the PAUS community. It was noted that the PAUS leadership requested a summary level update by the parents/caregivers on the School Council, and this was submitted at the end of Feb to the School leadership for distribution across the school in advance of the Elections.
- Any Other Business: update on the Spring Conferences. There was some discussion about these, and it was shared that we do not have funding in the SIP budget to hold these conferences. It was noted to take this discussion offline.
