Listening Conference Family Survey 8:20-8:55	<ul> <li>Goal of Family Survey: Get data on any strengths, areas of growth and equity concerns from family perspective</li> <li>Take 5 minutes to review the survey draft&gt;&gt;. Notes about this draft</li> <li>More open-ended questions about what the best way to communicate and about translation issues weren't added because we already know that these are issues for some</li> </ul>

families and would like to get this information through
focus groups versus a broad survey.
<ul> <li>Questions were organized into broad categories (that were influenced by the self-assessment criteria for an equitable school)</li> </ul>
After you review, discuss
<ul> <li>Ways to condense these questions and put it in more plain language?</li> <li>Anything missing?</li> <li>Other comments/ideas <ul> <li>Having 'please explain your answer' after each question may seem unwieldy- might be better to have one at the ned</li> <li>Clarification question - what about families that don't do the listening conference?</li> <li>Where does this fall in the self-assessment?</li> <li>What is going to be done with the data? Is there some active plan to act on this data?</li> <li>ABB focus groups - relationship was the biggest connecting factors about what folks were</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<ul> <li>concerned with and communication in a timely fashion</li> <li>Communication is really linked to HOW people get information</li> <li>Good to find out if the methods that the school is using works for families</li> <li>In the past, people were saying they were getting information from their kids before the school</li> <li>'I know how to' was a big barrier - folks were more concerned w/ 'I know who to'</li> <li>Fairly - has a broad interpretation across lot so different backgrounds, so might be better to find a different word</li> <li>'Yes, no sometimes' - what about 'always, sometimes, never'</li> <li>usually/sometimes/rarely? I like avoiding absolutes in surveys**</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Length- OK (keep the explain more to one question)</li> <li>Is there a place to put a question - 'my student's unique identity is respected at my school'?</li> <li>Can we add a question on the survey if families are interested in doing a focus group?</li> <li>Anonymous/non-anonymous aspect?</li> </ul>
	How to communicate this to families? What would be good to include
	<ul> <li>How this survey will be used</li> <li>Way to convey your family's experience and that it would be a way to be considered and added to an action plan, whatever that may be</li> <li>ABB focus groups - past negative feedback was that people got surveys but action hasn't been done; so might be good to lead w/ how data has been used in the past so people don't feel like they're wasting their time</li> <li>Commitment to follow-up w/ survey to share that information/results w/ families and how it's going to be used</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>For educators</li> <li>Having bulleted talking points so families all have a consistent message</li> </ul>
