Hear from student reps 8:10-8:35	<p>Introduce &amp; hear from student reps about why they joined</p> <p>Orient students to what a School Improvement Plan and what one part of our plan is. Then get their feedback on how to make our next action step most successful:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Context: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ What—a survey to give families after Listening Conferences. <a href="#">Link to survey&gt;&gt;</a></li> <li>○ Why—to hear from all families about how welcome they feel and how much they trust the school</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Discussion question: <i>What ideas do students have about how we might get students involved in making sure families complete the survey?</i></li> </ul>
Equity self-assessment tool 8:35-8:55	<p>Summary of district expectations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Members of the school-based equity teams will complete the self-assessment individually and from their own perspective by February 11th</li> <li>● Members have been sent a link with their log-in information to a website where they can complete the self-assessment. Everyone receive it?</li> <li>● Sections to complete <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ School Policy</li> <li>○ Assessing Community Needs</li> <li>○ School Climate/Environment</li> <li>○ Staff</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If there is a question that does not apply or you don't know the response, leave it blank. If it is not being implemented but it could be, consider rating it as "Latent (0 Points)". <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ See <a href="#">rating explanations</a></li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Troubleshooting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Can you log in?</li> <li>● Can you see the survey?</li> <li>● Clarification questions? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ What will we do with this data from the self-assessment and consensus building?- still unclear <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Based on our responses → where are we as a school council?</li> <li>■ Our responses &amp; family survey data → any immediate action steps we can take this year? What other info do we need? Long-term direction as a school?</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Does it save automatically? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Yes but you should use it on the SAME device <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Choose the device you will complete it on and then it will save and you can go back at any point</li> </ul> </li> <li>■ For the other sections that we are not required to complete, just skip them</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Community members might leave a lot blank - is that OK? YES</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Discussion of next steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Have two tasks: survey results and building of consensus rating</li> <li>● Thoughts on priority for March Mtng? Which should we postpone until April? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Priority is listening conference family survey data</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p>Wrap up with next steps 8:55-9:00</p>	<p>Next mtg (March 1, 2022)</p> <p>Tasks before next mtg</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Adjust questions from family survey that were not as clear</li> <li>➤ Add note to family survey to make it clear that survey is for families</li> <li>➤ Look into translation/interpretation options</li> <li>➤ Make &amp; provide paper copies for students</li> <li>➤ Share family survey data in advance of next school council meeting so people who'd like to can browse ahead of time <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ At next mtg, we will work together to identify themes for open responses and discuss survey results</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
