School Council is approaching the end of year 1. New elections are coming up.

Chatter feedback loop is helpful, but we currently don't have enough of that.

Are there issues we can work on as a council proactively?

Specificity â€" not necessarily having an agenda - but introducing a topic that people can discuss and work on collaboratively, for example as follows:

discipline

homework

refining language in student handbook

Council goes to the community - meet with other parents to brainstorm, listen, and see what families' concerns are, what can we work on.

How do we draft this message to make it appealing for families to come to school council meetings? (Oksana)

Locus of control - what families and schools can work on together. Our locus of control is the things we do differently from other schools. District decisions are not within our control.

We want the factors unique to us to be informed by and supported by our community (Jess)

logistical issues we have no reminders for meeting
we have no shared notes
we should have a newsletter
School council is a part of family engagement.
functions as an advisory group (worst version)
for people interested in school policy - not every family is that wonky
school council is only one prong of engagement. There's no one way to be engaged.
We do a better job of selling this if people are already interested in school governance
and policy.
